**Axsys Air to Provide Classes to RV Builders at New Learning Center**  
**- Company Intends to Launch at Arlington Fly-in -**

(Seattle, WA) – Axsys Air, the newly formed company based in Lake Stevens, Washington, announced today that it intends to provide four or five intensive, multi-day workshops in a 5,000 square foot learning center to current and prospective RV builders.

“We have been looking at the market for some time now,” noted the Company’s founder Eric Gorrell. “With the advent of the new RV-12 light sport and the popularity of the 4-place RV-10, we think that this is a great time jump in feet first, so to speak.”

Axsys will be drawing from a pool of local instructors, but will rely primarily on its three founders for much of the coursework and expertise. Together, they have been involved in building RVs for the past two decades, including a 6A, 7A and a 10. Their next project will be the new RV-12.

According to Gorrell, the doors should open at the Arlington Fly-in in mid-July. “We intend to make quite a splash at Arlington, have our website up-and-running be ready to accept reservations” he added.
